

CWFI Delinquency Guidelines

If a delinquency occurs, a CWFI will no longer be considered “in good standing.” “Delinquency date” is defined as thirty days following the end of the certification.

The following addresses what will be considered delinquent if CWFI dues are not received in a timely manner, and how to reestablish good standing.

1. If the CWFI status is **within three years** of the delinquency date **with proof of CEUs**, submit proof and pay \$10 for each year considered delinquent, with a maximum fee of \$30.
2. If the CWFI status is **within three years** of the delinquency date but **have no proof of CEUs**, pay \$50. There is no need to retake the exam.
3. If the CWFI status is delinquent **more than three years**, pay \$50 and retake the exam.

Completion of the relevant steps above will restore “in good standing” status.
